**Deacon Jim's "A Moment with Our Lady"**

For over 660 years, people have come on pilgrimage to Aachen, Germany to venerate four relics preserved in its cathedral since the time of Charlemagne.

Historical records show that Emperor Charlemagne received a gift of relics from Jerusalem around the 800 AD. Since 1349, these relics have been presented to the faithful in Europe and around the world every seven year, and for that purpose, they are taken out of the golden reliquary of the Virgin Mary in the Aachen Cathedral for a period of ten days.

These relics are pieces of Ancient fabrics described as:

- The dress worn by Mary on the night of Jesus' birth.
- Jesus' swaddling clothes with which Mary protected the Child.
- The sheet that wrapped the head of Saint John the Baptist after his beheading.
- The loincloth Jesus wore on the Cross.
