LITURGICAL REFLECTION...

The Christmas season recalls the early manifestations connected to the revelation of this newborn Child. Today three men, bearing gifts, come from the East to honor and adore the newborn King. Jesus Christ does not belong to any particular people or nation. He is the Savior of all; he is the King of all the nations. This Epiphany we are reminded that we must go out and announce this good news. Jesus is the Savior of all peoples and nations. We evangelize all who hunger and thirst.
