**CATHOLIC APPEAL- Goal Exceeded; In Final Weeks:**  
With \$53,882.70 in pledges from 282 families, we have exceeded our diocesan assigned goal and with everyone's help we can address the choir loft carpeting and the between-the-church-and-the-rectory paving projects.
