**Patronage: Animals, animal welfare societies, against dying alone, zoos, needleworkers, ecologists, Franciscan order.**

**Profile: St. Francis was born in 1182, the son of a rich cloth merchant. He had a good education and joined in the family business. After a care free youth, he turned his back on the family wealth and committed himself to God. He founded the Franciscans based on a simple statement by Jesus: "Leave all and follow me" He lived a life of poverty and lived with and cared for animals. He died in 1226 of natural causes.**
