MASS TIMES IN CHINA Finding Mass on Sundays becomes challenging in non-Christian Countries. China is no exception. So far I have found Masses for Beijing and Shanghai – getting to them may be an adventure. I remember walking several miles through Ankara, Turkey only to being kept from Mass because I had no identification. I failed to have a copy of my passport. Chengdu, in Sichuan China, lists a Catholic mission. Its last bishop died in 1987. Last available statistics shows 0.2% of the population Catholic. Beijing has not had a named bishop since 1967; Shanghai since 2000. AS Dorothy said, "We're not in Kansas any more."
