**Families and the Gospel**

June 11 Mt 28: 16-20  
Even though the apostles “doubted.” Jesus still gave them a clear mission. It is normal that children will doubt their parents. Like Jesus in today's gospel, parents must be clear about their expectations. Clarity is a gift we give our children; doubt is a search for direction and the first step to insight.

**LITURGICAL REFLECTION...**

We believe in one God who is Creator, Redeemer, and Giver of Life. Our Profession of Faith at Mass confesses that God is the maker of heaven and earth, of all that is seen and unseen. The Creed also professes that Jesus Christ is Lord and Son of God who suffered, died, rose from the dead and is coming again in glory. We proclaim that the Holy Spirit is the source of our living in the one, holy, catholic and apostolic Church. We believe in one God, a Trinity of Persons. Three Persons equal in majesty, undivided in splendor, yet one Lord, one God.

**“IN DEFENSE OF LIFE”**

Speaking about the scientific exploitation of human embryos, the future Pope Benedict XVI stated, “I would like to recall that already once before, medical experiments were carried out on persons who were held to be inferior. Where will the logic that consists in treating a fetus or an embryo as a thing lead?”
