Liturgical Reflection... Particular feasts within a diocese may be added to the liturgical calendar provided the universal calendar of the Church remains intact. In the Diocese of Altoona-Johnstown May 27 is the date of our establishment as a Diocese (1901) in the universal Church. When this day does not fall on a Sunday, the Local Church observes the feast of the principal patroness of the Diocese, Mary, Mother of the Church. This title was given to the Blessed Mother by Pope Paul VI following the Second Vatican Council. When May 27 falls on a weekday, The Diocese prays through the intercession of Mary to watch over, protect, and guide the people of the Allegheny Mountains, the sisters and brothers of her Son, our Savior and Lord Jesus Christ.
