(1579-1639)*

**Patronage:** for all who work for Social Justice.

**Profile:** Born in Lima, Peru, to a Spanish knight and an Indian from Panama, Martin and his sister were half-castes in a society where this meant loss of privilege. He entered the Dominican Friary at the age of 15 and served as barber, infirmarian, farm-laborer and became well known for his care of the sick and the poor. He spent his nights in rigorous prayer and penance alone with God, and his days totally absorbed in caring for the sick and the poor. May we learn from him how to speak out for God in a society that has great difficulty dealing with race, poverty and care for the outcast.
