LITURGICAL REFLECTION...

The cantor is both a singer and a leader of congregational song. Especially when no choir is present, the cantor may sing in alternation or dialogue with the assembly. As a leader of congregational song, the cantor should take part in singing with the entire gathered assembly. In order to promote the singing of the liturgical assembly, the cantor's voice should not be heard above the faithful gathered for Mass. Cantors should lead the assembly from a place where they can be seen by all without drawing attention from the liturgical action. The cantor exercises his or her ministry from a conveniently located stand, but not from the ambo.
