**LITURGICAL REFLECTION...**

What will be new or particularly different about the revised translation of the Roman Missal? From **Ratio Translationalis** comes this explanation. The unique style of the Roman Rite should be maintained in translation. By "style" is meant the distinctive way in which the prayers of the Roman Rite are expressed. The principal elements of such a style include a certain conciseness in addressing, praising and entreating God, as well as distinctive syntactical patterns, a noble tone, a variety of less complex rhetorical devices, concreteness of images, repetition, parallelism and rhythm.
