Where are we in the preparation for the third edition of the *Roman Missal* here in our country? The United States Conference of Catholic Bishops has passed the proposed Translations onto the Vatican. We in this country await Rome's *recognitio* of the texts presented to the Congregation for Divine Worship and the Discipline of the Sacraments. Once the Holy See has approved the texts, then our bishops will direct publishing companies to proceed with the printing of the *Roman Missal* for use in the United States.
