These changes will take effect the weekend of July 31 and August 1. **Our new schedule will be: Saturday 4:00 p.m., Sunday 8:00 a.m., 10:30 a.m., and 12 Noon.** We apologize for the inconvenience this may cause some, but it was felt that these are necessary changes.

LITURGICAL REFLECTION...

The third edition of the Roman Missal in Latin was published in 2002. Our current translation dates to 1973, and some parts of the Mass first appeared in English as early as 1970. After a generation of usage, the translation we know well is being revised to reflect the current Latin edition. Translators now have a firmer grasp of the meaning of the original texts and of the demands of oral proclamation. The revised translations will have more depth. As people say and hear the new words, they should appreciate even more the value of the faith they hold so dear.
